Dear Supporters, Volunteers, and Friends of Life's Key Ministry,

I am happy to report an answer to prayer! After a lot of product testing and procedure review the last couple of months, we were able to make the appropriate adjustments and implement a new mailing system. This is ultimately a way for us to save on postage, which is easily our biggest expense.

The software allows us to save because it does the extra work that the post office would normally do. After submitting the list of students we are going to mail to each week through the software, along with their institution information and the approximate weight of each package, the data is returned with special fields that I am able to print out right onto the envelopes. There is a bar code that includes information about the zip code and weight. There is another string of numbers that can break the packages down as far as carrier route. And each envelope has a counter which indicates that they have been packed in the exact chronological order that they need to be. These things save the post office time, which results in lower rates for us.

We had been paying 32.6 cents per package until we started using the software. Now, based on how many packages we have and where they are going on a given week, all of the addresses that the software can validate (which is all but one or two each mailing) are being sent for less. Some are going for 28.7 cents, some for 25.4, some for 11, and incredibly some are able to be sent for 6.4 cents! Over the course of the three mailings that have been done, we have saved between 13% and 24% each time. What a blessing from the Lord!

It is my hope that I can use the software to save on our birthday cards and first class mail as we move forward. Please continue to keep this project in prayer as this will be harder to figure out than the bulk mail, but I am confident that we are only just beginning to see the benefits that are possible!
