Last year was one of trials and triumphs for us. Any change in leadership results in a transition period, and I feel that everyone has shown a remarkable flexibility to adapt. We ran into trouble with some building issues, but were able to make the necessary upgrades thanks to savings we had built up and financial support. The borough worked on the road next to our office off and on from April to November, but we showed patience, and now we don't have to deal with muddy tap water and volunteers having to park further away anymore. And most recently, we had a large amount of courses misplaced by the post office on their way to our counselors. Thankfully most were found and delivered two weeks later and have since been returned to the inmates.

All that being said, God continues to bless us beyond measure! Last year I was able to meet and talk with so many wonderful people who care about this ministry and provide an update on how God is using us. I was also given the opportunity to go to a few churches that hadn't heard of us before and share with them what we are all about. We launched a website and implemented a new logo. A number of new volunteers have come on board. We added six courses to our curriculum, and the inmates are learning a lot from them. We are now reaching out to inmates in Rhode Island and New York. Finally, God provided the means for us to send out over 29,000 courses to current and former inmates in 2014. His word is getting through!

Please continue to pray for Life's Key! There are so many that need to learn of God's love, and all we want to do is reach out with the materials and feedback they need to gain that better understanding. We know who holds tomorrow, but don't know how many tomorrow's we have left! Pray that the sense of urgency remains strong, obstacles are minimal, and that God will use us to our maximum potential. He has been good!
