We will see a heavy amount come in for a few weeks, and then it will decrease for a few weeks. The reasons could be many, but things generally have evened out. That being said, what is happening so far in 2019 has been eye opening. From the first week of January, mail has been steadily increasing, and is not showing any signs of slowing down!

There are several reasons for this, including our new partnership with Set Free Prison Ministries in California. They send a different type of Bible study nationwide, but are now suggesting as their students finish up that program, that they can reach out to Life's Key if they would like to learn more about the Lord. We've gotten many new students from that. Also, our presence in Florida continues to grow each week. We have already mailed more courses there this year than we did all of last year. But most importantly, this is an answer to prayer! I've asked you to pray for growth, and growth is what we have!

More students means more office work, more courses going out, more supplies needed, more postage, and a need for enough commenters to handle what has come in each week. We are thankful to Him as we strive to reach more and more in His precious name.

I am locked in a room all day with plenty of time trying to figure out how I got here. My son passed away and the state took my other children. I was a single mom of 6. 3 girls and 3 boys. What a blessing God gave me, but I learned how fast you can lose everything in just seconds.

My life has changed forever. I have no family alive except my children. I won't be able to see them until they are 18 and over. I have had a rough life growing up, being abused by my dad, my mom not wanting me. My grandparents raised me. When I left I got into much trouble, but I felt my grandmother had a shield of protection over me because she prayed for me. When she passed away, all this bad stuff came and attacked me, and did not stop until I ended up here.

I realized she had God with her and that is why nothing could attack her. I want to be like her and have the peace she had. I know it starts with trust, faith, and patience, which is hard for me. But I am learning little by little. I know I will get there one day. This is a test for me to see how strong I am and how much trust I have in God. I know I will pass this one day because my problem is an answer for someone else.

I want to learn more. You can never stop learning about God, the Bible, and His plans for my family and I. I want to be a better mother for my children. I just want to learn and learn and not stop. Anything that could help my process of getting closer to God and know Him better. What His plans are for me. There is so much to learn. If you could send me anything, it would be greatly appreciated. We learn from others. Thank you.
