Course Highlight: WALKIN' THE WALK

"Walkin' the Walk" is another course that resonates with prisoners because it was written by an ex-offender, specifically for those who are incarcerated. The author is Lennie Spitale and the course was first published in 2012. The teachings he provides are based solidly on the Word of God and flow out of his personal experience behind prison walls and his later fulltime ministry to inmates since being released. The subtitle of the course is "A Practical Guide to Christians in Prison" and it's 10 chapters touch on topics such as Christianity in a fishbowl, maintaining unity among Christians, serving others, the Biblical view of authority, and the importance of integrity. We are mailing about 80 of these per month, and are thankful to have one of three slots we have designated to fill the cost covered by a course sponsor.
