Those 6 men are the unnamed thief who trusted Christ while hanging on the cross beside Him, the centurion who crucified Christ, Pontius Pilate, Herod Antipas, Judas, and Nicodemus. Each of these men had a response to Christ, and the course asks of the reader, "What is your response to Christ?"
