I received a letter from an inmate dated January 16 simply notifying me that he had just received the two courses we sent him. Those courses were mailed on November 21, so it took a while, but they got there. Ideally as time goes on, the processing facility we now send the courses to will get them out faster. Even still, we thank God for answered prayer and His grace and mercy shown for His children!

Please keep me in prayer as I am preparing to venture to Florida at the end of the month. Al Stoltz (Emmaus International Prison Ministry Director) and I will be speaking at churches in Orlando and Jacksonville. We will also be visiting Columbia Correctional Institution and Florida State Prison. Our goals are to promote the prison ministry and the Emmaus courses, as well as encourage those in the prisons and some volunteers that are already involved. It should be a fruitful time in an area where so many are showing a desire for the Lord.
