Dear Supporters, Volunteers, and Friends of Life's Key Ministry,

We have made progress in a number of areas this past month on some outstanding issues. First, we are seeing more positive results in Michigan. Each week I have been sending a few courses with covers and a few exams graded with red ink into those institutions. Last week we received a set of completed exams from one of those packages, meaning that the inmate received his courses without issue. We also have not received any letters of rejection because of the red ink, so things continue to head in the right direction!

Second, we are almost near the end of the lease on our deluxe printer / copier and had been contemplating whether to buy it at market value or search for another machine. We decided that it would be smartest to at least try another printer that we could return within 30 days if it couldn't do what we need. After some initial testing, I'm happy to report that it looks like this could be the answer to our need! It may require an extra attachment, so some questions remain unanswered, but the important thing is that it will all be taken care of with a one-time purchase instead of another long-term lease. An answered prayer years in the making!

Finally, I would like to announce that we have taken steps to change our mailing address. The main reason for this is because there is a post-office about 15 minutes closer to Life's Key than our current post-office, and it is on-the-way instead of out-of-the-way for those of us that pick up the mail. Because we have so many pre-printed publications with our current PO Box number, we will continue to keep that open until the end of 2018, and mail will be forwarded to our new box during 2019. For now, either address can be used, and I will send a notice when PO Box 10 is closed. This is a big change for us, but one that I am glad is finally happening! Slowly but surely, you will see the address on all our publications change to:
