Dear Supporters, Volunteers, and Friends of Life's Key Ministry,

I'd like to take the time to say a special "thank you" to all of the people who give so generously of their time in a volunteer role for Life's Key. I am also extremely thankful for your flexibility and your willingness to learn new things. I realize that I have asked a lot of you lately as procedures continue to change.

The decision was made back in June to change our curriculum to match the one suggested by Emmaus, and that brought a myriad of changes along with it. Learning the new course order, the new course abbreviations, and which courses now get sent together have all taken some getting used to. We also went through the process of updating all of our exam sheets in an effort to make things clearer for our students. New grading masks needed created, and we had to adjust what we check when mail comes in, as well as when we mail back completed exams. Most significantly, after many years with the same questions on the exam sheets, we have changed the thought questions for every course to mirror those suggested by Emmaus. This has been a big adjustment for our course commenters, and we continue to work through suggestions on what can be improved. Also, as of October 1, all institutions in the state of Michigan are no longer allowing anything written in red ink. With so many students in Michigan, we have had to adjust our grading and commenting (usually done in red) to account for that. Please pray for us as we try to keep up with the ever changing institution regulations.

Once again, thank you to the amazing group of volunteers that are part of this ministry. Most, if not all of you, have had to make an adjustment here or there. These changes have been made to benefit our students by giving them a more comprehensive study of God's word, by simplifying the process, and by encouraging growth in new students interested in the free gift of courses, and Christ's free gift of salvation. I couldn't ask for a more dedicated and loving group of people!
