While we experienced a spike in interest last year, especially when there were more unknowns with the pandemic, those numbers have gradually come back down over the course of 2021. Part of that is a result of the ever-growing restrictions implemented in certain states and certain prisons. This is expected, but we continue to pray that the Lord will open more doors than are closed and guide the hearts of more prisoners to Him through our courses. Your continued prayers are appreciated!

Course Highlight: PROVERBS FOR LIFE

“Proverbs for Life” is sent along with “Perfect Person, Perfect Work” as part of our “Intro to the Bible” section of the curriculum. It is written by Dick Hopkins, who was arrested at an early age and came to Christ while in a county jail at age 24. He wrote this course specifically for men and women in prison or on parole using his experience as a new Christian studying the book of Proverbs. It focuses on those principles that will help them live out their Christian lives such as having Godly friends, a righteous work ethic, self-control, sexual purity, and being humble. We are currently mailing about 40 of these per month, and it is being paid for through the sponsorship program.
