We continue to mail out more and more courses to inmates across the country. Thankfully, despite all of the covid chaos, we have not experienced any further mailing restrictions into our institutions outside of what we are already used to. There have been some federal prisons that are starting to require things like single-sided answer sheets and blue / black ink only, which results in extra work and mail being returned if we are not extremely careful, so please pray those additional requirements would be kept to a minimum.

I am also excited to announce that we have made some adjustments to our curriculum in an effort to enhance our student's experience. The courses will now be broken down into more logical groups of 7-10 courses, and we will plan to issue special benchmark certificates as they complete each group. The new curriculum will also include these four new courses: "The Greatest Man Alive", "Dying to Self", "God's Word is Truth", and "Genesis 1-12". These courses will touch on some topics that will add to the well-rounded nature of the curriculum and further enhance our students' knowledge of the Bible. They keep telling us that they are working on moving some of us, so I was waiting until I got here to send it.

This is the last place I will be until its time for me to go home. They still have not given me an official release date, but I'm praying if it's God's will to let me be home with my family next year. I know in my heart I'm not the addict I was when I got locked up, and I want to be able to show the parole officer, judge, and everyone else that thinks I can never change, that I can and did. Most importantly I want to show my family and the ones that have never given up on me that there was a better person in me if I would just search for Him.

I want to get out and do the work of the Lord and bring His word to the young in my town so they don't go down the road I went down. Thank you for all your help in my coming to know my Savior better." – Michael (Virginia)
