Course Highlight: GOOD NEWS FOR ALL

"Good News for All" is sent along with "God is There" as part of our "Intro to the Bible" section of the curriculum. It is written by William McDonald, first published in 2016, making it one of the newer courses that we send. This course is centered around the book of Romans. While we also have a more challenging course on Romans that is sent later, this course is a more simplistic teaching of the truths found in that book, ideal for a new believer. The reader will learn that the gospel is "the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes", as well as how to respond to God's grace and mercy in our daily lives. We are currently mailing around 60 of these per month, and it is being sponsored by two of our course sponsors.
